Many of you has heard me tell this before, and—and sinking into an endless Eternity. First, I was going through like clouds, and then through darkness, and sinking on down, down, down. And the first thing you know, I got into the regions of the lost, and in there I—I screamed. And I looked, and there, just everything, there was no foundation to it. I could never stop falling. For Eternity, looked like, I was going to fall. There was no stopping, nowhere. 80 And then what a difference it was from the vision I had here, not long ago, of being in Glory with the people, the contrast! But in this, as I was falling, I finally,

I-I screamed for my daddy. Course, being just a kid, that's what I would do. I screamed for my daddy, and my daddy wasn't there. And I screamed for my mother, "Somebody catch me!" There was no mother there. I was just going. And I screamed then to God. There was no God there. There was nothing there. 81 And after a while I heard the most mournful sound that I ever heard, and it was the awfulest feeling. There is no way...Even a literal burning fire would be a pleasure to the side of what this was. Now those visions has never been wrong. And it was just one of the most horrible feelings I ever had, and what did... 82 I heard a noise, sounded like some kind of a—a—a haunted affair. And when it was, I looked, coming, and it was women. And they had green stuff, just could just see their face, and they had green stuff under their eyes. And their eyes looked like run back, like the women today paint their eyes, run back like that, and just their eyes and face. And they were going, "Ooh, ooh, ooh, ooh!" Oh, my! 83 I just screamed out, "O God, have mercy upon me. Have mercy, O God! Where are You? If You'll only let me go back and live, I promise You, to be a good boy." Now, that's the only thing I could say. Now, God knows, and at the Day of Judgment, He'll judge me for that statement. That's what I said, "Lord God, let me go back, and I'll promise You I'll be a good boy." 84 And when I got shot, I had told lies, I had done pretty near everything there was to be done, only one thing that I say... I might as well just clean it out while I'm right here now. And when I looked down and seen I was half blowed in two, almost, I said, "God, have mercy on me. You know I never did commit adultery." That was the only thing I could say to God. I had never accepted His pardon, and all these things. I just say, could say, "I never did commit adultery." 85 And then they taken me out there. I thought, "Oh, let it be that I'll never go to a place like that; no other human being will ever have to go to a place like that."

And what a sad thing is when you see people that's trying to find, trying to find security and peace in some form of happiness in the material blessings of this world and yet don't seemly have any knowledge of their soul, where did they come from and where they going.

I'm so thankful tonight friend, that we found out where we come from and where we're going, the Lord Jesus shinned upon our pathway and give us a blessed hope. We ought to keep our cheeks bathed with tears.

Now, lets bow our heads in a word of prayer. I see some of us not here tonight, maybe they're sick. I want us all to just right now sincerely, pray for...I notice brother Kenny's wife, she isn't here, maybe she's sick. Is she sick? How many's sick here? I know Donny's wife, sister Harriet is sick, she's got a abscessed tooth that's really giving her a lot of pain. How many let's see your hands, your sick now? Let us all pray.

Maybe...where's the little sister that plays the organ? Maybe Ruthie somebody can play the organ, come down here and play the organ just a minute? Just play a little bit now, "The Great Physician Now Is Here."

Let's just wait real quietly for the presence of the Lord Jesus Christ. The same one that reveals his word, same one that reveals his word is the healer, the same one. There's no greater thing in the world today then God revealing his word. Jesus is here! If we could ever get a reality of who that is in your midst, that presence. Well, don't he know you're sick, don't he know your trials, don't he know all those things, sure he does. He's not way off somewhere, he's right here tonight in this building. That one that you have felt many, many times come into your midst and do you feel that supernatural presence, that's the same one that people felt when they come close to Brother Branham and that pillar of fire, that's him. And one day, how amazed you all will be, when you find out that presence that you feel, is gonna be, is going to become personalized in your life. He's right here tonight.

## Page 4-7 CONVERSATION ABOUT BUILDING OR RENTING ANOTHER CHURCH

I mentioned to some of the brothers, that they would like to and come to my home tomorrow night. But then I got to thinking, it kinda leaves the sisters out, you know. I thought if it wouldn't be kinda out of order, I'm kind of pressed on it and I'd like to put something before the church because this is your church, you're the church and I'd like to bring it before you because of the lease on this building. I think I mentioned sometime before, kinda casual but didn't kinda emphasize anything and I thought I would get it off of my heart. Brother Ruddell was kinda talking to me about it this week, I thought I'd mention it to you and that is about our building here.

It looks to me like the Lord if the terries and I have no assurance when the Lord Jesus is coming. As I said this morning, I'm looking for him tonight. I don't know when He'll be here, but we'll be waiting for Him because we don't have nowhere else to go.

Now I'd adventure to say, if the Lord terries a few more years, a couple years or so, we're not gonna be able to hold the people here because they gonna...the family come here another one and another one. And then if you have any extra meetings, there's just, we don't have the facilities in this building to take care of near what we got in here now. The nurseries jammed and packed and it's hard on the sisters in there and they can't take care of the babies. And then we have our foot washing services and the minsters sits out in the car and people come by and it's a... If we ever get going here... it's our building, just the bathroom here, we keep letting the nursery out, to build there's not enough room. And we kinda joke before, that if the Lord terries the nurseries gonna take the building over. And then thinking it's very inconvenient for the women folk. And you know and God knows, you know that I'm not much for a building programs, I never have been.

But then again, I'm reminded of the farmer that Brother Branham said, "Go ahead and plant your corn, plant your potatoes, go ahead and build you a church." He said, "I'd rather be caught, the Lord Jesus catch me putting my money into a building, then putting my money into my pocket, that's how I feel about." The mortgage payment that we're paying on this piece of property out here, is outrages, it's outrages for what we get out of it. The building...it's alright for me, but for the money that were putting out, it's very inadequate. We just don't have the facilities to take care of what we have got here and if they keep coming. And then Fire Marshall, then we're gonna be standing around here and then it maybe we get by a little while, but down the road, we'll run into problems and you can't rent buildings there's just none to rent for us. We like to have never found this.

And so, I thought, the ladies here husbands, all of us together kinda think about this. It don't cost much to put up a cinderblock building. And it would...of course we say, "Well it's so late." I know it is. But you see, we've been in this building about five years now. And with the money we spend on it, we could of sure had a lot better building then we now. If we put up a building the mortgage payment wouldn't be as near what it is here.

And I even mentioned it to a couple of brothers, that I'd sell my home to take what money I had and rent me a house and take what cash I had into it and put it all in to a building for you, for your comfort. Especially the lady folks in the nursery and the men needs a prayer room and a foot washing room and the building it's just not adequate. But if it's your desire to try to stay right here, that's...you're the church, it's up to you. But I thought, if it's pleasing to the church, if we could just maybe just...don't think of what the other one thinks, you're an individual you cast your vote. And then if we could just bring it before the church, and we wouldn't just have to bring the men tomorrow night, unless they wanted to come, to kinda... or we could do that, to seek into that a little further. And we're not... and when we have a little boat here, tonight it won't make a decision on it, but it will cause us to pray and to seek into it further. And that is, I don't think it would take much over just a few weeks to put up a cinderblock building. Then later on as we go on, we put a little sheet-rock and insulated it and but just to put a rook on it and that's about all we got here. The heat comes through and goes right on you know, and so with the cool air too. And but we're still paying rent see.

And so, I thought, we haven't signed a lease yet, and I don't want to keep putting the man off. But I've been...we haven't went over to talk to him yet because I wanted to talk to you about it, before we talk to him. And even if I leased the building, it'd only be for another year. Because if the Lord Jesus terries another year or two years, we're not gonna have room here for people. And another thing, there's only one way that you can do, is keep-keep coming up front and its gonna push the preacher out the door here. And what it is, it's kinda hard to having people sit right up in your face preaching and it makes it kinda difficult. I know it does for brothers, the ministering brothers and myself too. It's nice to be back and have a little room. And you see how it is here right now. And if we have...As time goes on, pressures gonna get more and peoples... and it keeps leaking out about this, it's just gonna keep...it's gonna keep coming. And so, I think it'd be wise...wise for us to...if want to say, aw...yeah but we have a responsibility, we got a responsibility. And It's a lot easier to just shirk it off and say, well let's worry about it tomorrow, but then it'd catch upon ya, see. And we oughta kinda think these things over tonight and maybe what we could do.

Without you knowing it, I went looking for some property, without you'll knowing it but then I found at some time ago, about a year ago and I found out it was a lot higher than I thought it was. We wouldn't need much, an acre to just put up a little cinder-block building and get a mortgage on it, shouldn't be too much. And I don't know that he would, but dad Collins in Florida, I've just started to hint to him a few times, but he's a...he's a really gifted in building. And I thought with Sister Norma and myself and brother Gerry maybe we couldn't kinda-kinda

hint to him and pray and prevail upon him to come up. And if you ever seen him put up cinderblock, you'd know you'd be in the thing, just in a few days. And we'd ask him if he would come up a few days and kinda...get some time off and see that the building goes up and we could furnish him some labor. And I don't know how it would work out, but I thought, well I'll just bring it to you and you know, and let you pray about it and see what think about it. It won't be no great, great big a forty fifty-thousand-dollar building, it'll be just a shell with a roof over it, a cinder-block shell with a roof over it, but we want to make it big enough, where if the Lord terries, that when people come, we'll have a place to put them, but right now you see that we don't have. And then you have all this, everybody just jammed up together here in the summer and it makes it real bad. And especially about the women, we said about the nursery. We just can't go any further with the nursery and then our foot washing services and prayer rooms would be nice that if we could pray about this, see how-how it would work out.

Now I wondered if we couldn't... those that would think well...Remember what Brother Branham said...I know myself... I know myself...I told the brothers I'd be tickled to death; I would have been tickled to death to sell my house and get what equity out of it and ...an...an put it in a building for you, cause it's your church. And I don't believe in throwing everybody in debt, we're not going to do that, just throw everybody in debt mortgage and everything, no I don't think it would have to be done. I think if we go at it right and the Lord could help us, we could... we could work it out alright, without putting to much strain on-on anybody. Now I thought if you would want me, different brothers, brother... elder brothers here, brother Graybill and all of us Jimmy and Dale and all of us, kinda seek into it. Where we could find a little piece of land, I like this area, I believe the Lord God led me to this area and I'd like to stay here. And if this building was sufficient, he wanted to much for this property, forty some thousand, it just ain't worth it this old building, it ain't worth nothing. It's just cinder-block, it ain't put together to good either, but we couldn't buy this, because it's not worth the money he's asking for.

But surely the Lord knows these things to be that way, there's bound to be a little lot sitting around somewhere waiting for us. As I said this morning, "I don't know when the Lord is coming, it could be 1977, it maybe 76, it may be 75, I don't know." But you see, that it's not getting smaller, it's getting bigger. And then in the message, it's not even leaked out yet, the more it leaks out, the more is gonna be coming.

And every elected person that's elected walks into this place see's what's going on and hears the word, they just up root everything and they're here.

And then supposing we decide to stay here and the Lord would terry, why then it'd be something else. So, we need to think about this and I know it may kinda...say, "Well my, it looks like the Lord ain't coming," but remember what I said this morning, it takes a long-range vision. But I'm hoping and praying and trusting, that if we would move and the first block that would be laid, that the Lord Jesus would come that afternoon.

I'm just bringing it before you, I don't know how things are gonna work out. But it's no... Shirley tells me how crowded it is in there; it makes it awful hard on the women folk. And then the men, we don't have any place to wash feet really down there, it's kinda difficult, the bathroom down there. Yeah, I know if the city they ever put the pressure on us, they could give us a lot of trouble on this building.

So, I'd wonder now, maybe if we'd all just bow our heads, that way they would say, well...may if we'd have time pass out some pencils and papers, take a little vote that way... but if everybody would bow their head. Now this is just for me to see. Now if I see what the church

wants, then that's what I want, that's want I what. I want what you want. If you want to not even bother to look into it, then that's up to you, it's just what you want, that's what I want. Now with our heads bowed and our eyes closed. Now let me take...let's see the ladies, some of them ain't present. How many ladies feel like in their heart that if it'd be the will of the Lord, you would...you got a little babies and you see the need? A lot times women folks can see things sometimes a little better than we can along that line. How many women, it would...what would you think about it, your part you got a vote. I wonder, with nobody looking around with your heads bowed, somebody might say, they wanted it and the other one didn't. We don't want nobody feeling hurt or nothing. How many of the women folks that you think, if the Lord terries it would be needful and it's alright with you, let's see your hands you women, you'd think it'd be alright? Raise your hand if you... alright now how about the men, what do you think about it? Well, it looks like pretty well much more thinks it's needful, then those that think it's not needful.

So, I tell you what we'll do, the brethren and I will gather together and pray about it a little more and maybe go over and talk to Mr. Vanellick, maybe he would let us kinda rent this from month to month...month to month and not take a lease on it and just see how it goes, that way we can see and get out of it quick. And we'll just go along at it like that, pray and just keep praying and see how it works out.

So, maybe the Lord Jesus will be here and we won't have to do nothing about it. So, I thought I'd just like to see how you all felt about it.

## END OF CONVERSATION ABOUT BUILDING OR RENTING ANOTHER CHURCH

Now, if you'll open your bibles to First Corinthians the 11<sup>th</sup> chapter, I'd like to read from verse twenty-three.

1 Corinthians 11:23-34-Scripture Reading:

23 For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, That the Lord Jesus the same night in which he was betrayed took bread:

24 And when he had given thanks, he brake it, and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me.

25 After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me.

26 For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do shew the Lord's death till he come.

27 Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink this cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord.

28 But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup.

29 For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body.

30 For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.

31 For if we would judge ourselves, we should not be judged.

32 But when we are judged, we are chastened of the Lord, that we should not be condemned with the world.

33 Wherefore, my brethren, when ye come together to eat, tarry one for another.

34 And if any man hunger, let him eat at home; that ye come not together unto condemnation. And the rest will I set in order when I come.

May God add a blessing to His word.

Now, I heard it said, that some did not understand, who should take communion and who should not take communion. So, I...so I took it upon myself maybe to speak to you about ten minutes on-on this ordinance the Apostle Paul received from the Lord Jesus. The Apostle Paul received the ordinance of Communion the Lord's supper, directly from the Lord Jesus. He received it by a divine revelation and said that, "He received it from him and was committing it unto us. That every time we take communion, the bread and the wine we are showing the Lord's death." In otherwards we are...we are communing one with another. Communion means to fellowship talk and we as the body of believers, when we take communion, are showing one another that this is what we have in common and that is the body of the Lord Jesus. And we're-we're showing one another, that we have-have taken are stand upon the word of God and that we have received the word of God.

Now-now notice, that if people see one of the body of believers in your congregation coming up and taking the communion and then they know that person is not living a Christian life, he's not living above sin, he's not living what the word of God declares for us to be living. And then they see that, then right away they become a great stumbling Stone and a great offense to the person that sees it. See!

And so therefore, the apostle Paul said, "That we should not take the communion unworthy or in a unworthily manner," and that is, to go out here and claim that you're a Christian, claim to be among the body of believers and then go out here, you lie, you pull all kinds of shady deals, in otherwards you live a loose haphazard life, and then you come up and take communion. Now, right away it shows a lack of sincerity and that's not discerning the body of the Lord Jesus. You're not discerning what that body did for you. You're not discerning that body suffered bled and died for you and you were deserving of dying and going to hell and then going to a Lake of Fire.

## Revelation 21:8-Reference quote:

8 But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.

But that body went to Calvary and died for you, and you're not rightfully discerning the Lord's body, you're not discerning what the Lord Jesus has done for you.

## 1 Corinthians 11:29-Reference quote:

29 For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body.

You don't realize, that He has saved you from your sins. You don't realize that He spared you out of all the world, and then you not living the life that you ought to live and then you come up and take communion, you're taking it in an unworthy manner and then you're subject to die. He said, "for this cause there's some, that are sickly among you."

# 1 Corinthians 11:30-Reference Scripture30 For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.

Said because that you're...you're not... What you do reacts upon the congregation. And we as a body of believers here, what I do reflects upon you, how I live reflects upon you and how you live reflects upon me and upon her and upon him, upon your brother and sister. See! And then we take come to the communion table... say well, you come up and take communion...Let's say it this way! They're some people that know that they shouldn't be taking communion, because they're convicted in their heart, they're not living what they ought to be living. And then they come up and take communion because they don't want sister so an so to know that they didn't take communion. They don't want the sister to know there's something wrong with their life. Now see, that's an unworthy manner all together. You don't care what that, you don't care what this ones thinking, that's-that's up to them but you...you...you worry about you, your soul, see.

Naw, when people see that, when they see it, when people come, some newcomer comes some visitor comes and they see different ones out here in the world and see how they act, see how they live. Boy they're watching you, don't think they ain't! And a I've had that, people come right here to me and say, "Oh, you got, your church is just like any other church, you got hypocrites in it, just like anywhere else." Yeah, yeah that's right! I can't help that though! And then they use that as an excuse as a stumbling stone, they say, "well they'd be better off just stay home. Well, they're worse off than the other person is, because they're least coming to church and trying a little bit." See!

But see, everybody out in the world is watching you. They're watching you; they just want you to make a mistake. Aw boy!

It was just like brother Parilli was telling me, said...and brother Parilli you know his life, there's nobody that strives and struggles to live any more of the word of God then brother George Parilli. And he said, "one, all this time he worked for this man and when he got ready to quit and gave his two weeks' notice, and George had forgot all about it. But then when he got ready to leave, he said, "brother Parilli," he said, "I'd like to say something," he said, "you know you claim to be a Christian said, you remember that time you got mad?" A George was talking about, he really didn't get mad, he might a talked a little strong. But that man never forgot that all that time, never forgot it. And he wanted to make sure that he mentioned it to him, to let him know. But he said, "that was wrong," he said "you shouldn't of done that as a Christian." Here him just an ungodly man, businessman but he knowed you should of done it. See!

Now, it's alright for you...it's alright for you women to wear them short dresses out there in the world, and they won't say nothing about it as long as you're in the world. But when you start talking about this Pentecostal message and the blessing of God, you better make sure that your hemline down over your knee or they're gonna tell you about it. That's right! Is that right? (*Amen*) They're watching you; they won't forget that. Now they'll forget all the good that you do, they'll forget all that, they won't remember that a lot of times. But they sure won't forget any mistakes that make. So, we got all the eyes of the world looking upon us.

That's why that our conversations... the Bible said that, "Our conversations should always be in heaven." See!

#### Philippians 3:20-Reference quote:

20 For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ:

#### 1 Peter 1:15-16-Reference quote:

15 But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; 16 Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.

Let the devil meet you out there and try to drag you in, to a little joking and jesting and the next thing you know, they'll crack a dirty little joke just to see what your gonna say about it. And then you sit there and listen to it, then they condemn you, turn around and say, "you shouldn't be listening to that." They're all laying, just, the devils out there just laying a snare all the time for us, see.

So, we-we got to walk in a manner, that when the other people are looking upon us...when they're looking upon us, then we want to make sure that we're walking as straight as we can with the word of God. Knowing they're gonna blame it all on the Lord Jesus, he's gonna bare all the reproach for us, so that's why we should strive and struggle to live by the word of God.

And then when we come up and take communion, as a body of believers we are...we are participating together as a little family. In that we're together here because of the body of the Lord Jesus that went to Golgotha and SUFFERED AND BLED AND DIED for you and I. You and I wouldn't be here tonight if it hadn't been for the body of the Lord Jesus hanging at CALVARY! Brother Graybill would be down in Pennsylvania and I'd be out in Arizona somewhere and you'd be somewhere else. Brother Teddy would be in Yugoslavia maybe somewhere. But we're here tonight as a body of believers because the body of the Lord Jesus that was crucified and died at Calvary.

So, I don't believe that children ought to take communion. I don't believe that children, little children ought to take communion, but I believe that the teenagers, if they are receiving the word of God in their soul and they are trying to live a Christian life and trusting to live for the Lord Jesus and trying to live by the word of God, then take communion.

But if your life...if your life is not trying to live the word of God, you shouldn't take communion. And you ought to judge yourself. You ought to judge yourself, that's why Paul said, "you judge yourself."

## 1 Corinthians 11:27-28-Reference quote

27 Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink this cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord.

28 <u>But let a man examine himself</u>, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup.

We ought to judge ourself, we ought, we are to examine ourself, to see whether or not we're living the word of God. Knowing that if someone see's us living loosely then and then they see us go up and take communion. Oh, I've seen that, I've watched that. How people boy, just watch and just see if that certain person is gonna come up and take communion. And then "Yeah, that's just what I thought!" So, it's a lot better to examine yourselves and sit there and not take it, then to come up and take communion and really not be in shape for it. I really believe that. Why? Is because, if there ever was an hour brother and sister, that you and I need to really be chuck-full sincerity is right now. You can't reverence the Lord Jesus enough in this hour. You can't fear the Lord enough in this hour. When you see the insanity that's going around all-all around are country and around our neighbors in our town, the people are going totally insane, they're getting worse every day they're going clear out of their mind. And then we think that our only hope out of here is the body of the Lord Jesus. And then we look arounds and see the millions and the billons that are in the shape they're in.

And then we see here, that God's Grace has shined upon our pathway, oh it ought to straighten us up and shake us up and just come oh with a heart filled with sincerity, realizing that the body of the Lord Jesus hung on Calvary's tree, that ole wooden tree for you and me. It's not just, well it's communion tonight, just come up and take communion and go back to your seat. That's what the Jews done!

The Jews one time, they had a...they had a ordinances for a... Moses had left them and a sacrifice for the sins and at one time when that... when they had, one time the Jews had sincerity and-and they...they drug that little bleeding Lamb down there to the priest to-to cut it's throat, to catch the blood in the laver to sprinkle it upon them, to forgive them for their sins. Why, they wept and they cried and-and just realized that the Lamb of God was coming one day and this little Lamb Here was-was pointing to that Lamb of God coming! And they had sincerity in what they was doing! And then later on years later, oh they just went down there just no sincerity at all with their Lamb and just...See!

I was all stretched out and, uh and I was just, stretched out, looked like I was dead, stiff as a board and I was layin out there and right over top of me was a fresh ball of blood, round ball moon like ball of blood. Just as red, look like it just come out of the veins. And then over top of that was a...was a...was a, the fire of God, that-that halo of fire turning around there over top of that blood. And I tell you when I come too, I was reallyreally stirred up by the power of God. God looking down at me through the blood.

God looking down at us through the Blood and that's how he's looking at you. You're trusting him for your supreme sacrifice for your sin and you got faith that he's your sacrifice and you're trying to live a Christian life and he's looking down at you through the Blood, take communion. But if you're sitting there, you're living out there, doing things that you know that you shouldn't do, then it'd be my advice, if I were you, I wouldn't take it, I wouldn't take it. Because it's not worth the chance, because if you drink it and eat the bread, drink the wine and eat the bread in a unworthy manner, why, then you know what he said.

So, I hope that helps you to understand. So, that why we're gonna terry for one for another, to realize that if it wasn't for the body of the Lord Jesus, oh brother Bill wouldn't be sitting here tonight, he probably died a long time ago an alcoholic, a ole alcoholic died on the street with nobody knowing it. When I think about ole Bill sitting here tonight, then I think about the body of the Lord Jesus that died for him. And that sitting here, think about, that's what we have in common, is the blood of the Lord Jesus Christ shed at Calvary, or we wouldn't be here together. See, it's all the grace of God. How many is glad for him doing that? (*Amen*)

Now, if our sisters would come, to the organ please. How many want to be more sincere? (*Amen*) There never was an hour that we need sincerity like we do now.

That blood song we sing sister, "At the cross," that'd be alright. Page 273 Now, let's listen to the words of this to.

Amen! Now, while our sisters play softly something else, we'll bow our heads. As Paul said, "Terry one for the other." Now if you know a brother or a sister in need, you pray for them one another now, now is the time to pray for one another.

Dear Father God, I bring my little congregation to you Lord, we wouldn't be here tonight if it wasn't for what you've done for us Father. Lord, we feel very short in ourselves, we realize Lord we're not what we want to be, but Lord we're so thankful, that we're not what we use to be. God we're thankful for every brother for every sister, that Grace has appeared to their pathway. Lord, that's what makes us love one another. To think Lord, that you would save us and bring us together and now Lord, we have this time of communion around your body, around your blood and we are doing this because that you told us to do it Lord. And as often as we do it, we are showing what you did for us at Calvary till you come. Father, may thy blessing rest upon us Lord, keep this little group together in the love of the Holy Ghost. Lord, lead us and guide us by your Holy Spirit, don't let us make one error, one mistake Lord, keep us close by your side. Help us to be sincere, preferring one another above ourselves. Help us to be servants for one another Lord. To not live just for ourselves but for each other. God, we thank you for saving each one Lord, thank you father. In Jesus name.

If our brothers will come. (Brothers come to serve communion.)

26 And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed it, and break it, and gave it to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body.

55 For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed.

56 He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him.

57 As the living Father hath sent me, and I live by the Father: so he that eateth me, even he shall live by me.

58 This is that bread which came down from heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead: he that eateth of this bread shall live for ever.

Oh hallelujah, thank you God! Oh, great Lord! Great God of heaven, amen. Hallelujah! Oh, Bless the name of the Lord! Thank you, Jesus! Hallelujah! Praise his Holy Name! Do you love him with all of your heart? (*Amen*)

Now, we're going to dismiss, the men go down to the catacombs (*Men go to the Basement for foot washing service*) and the ladies stay up here for foot washing.
